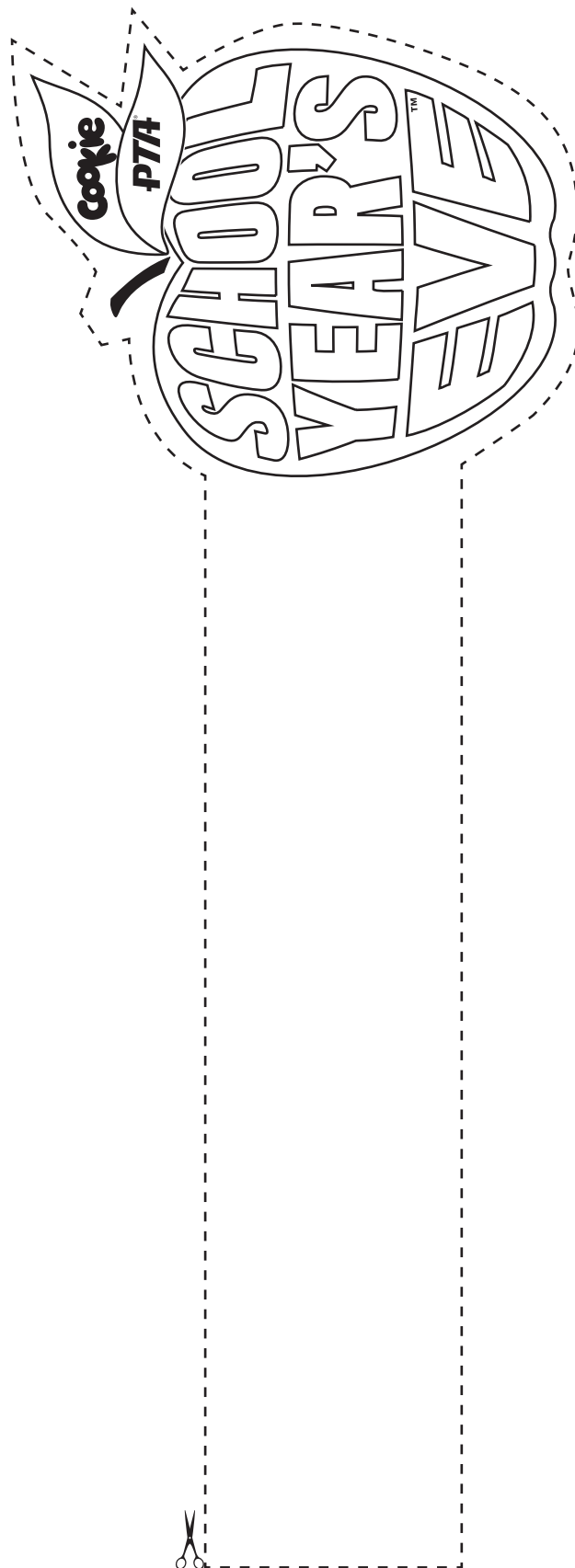
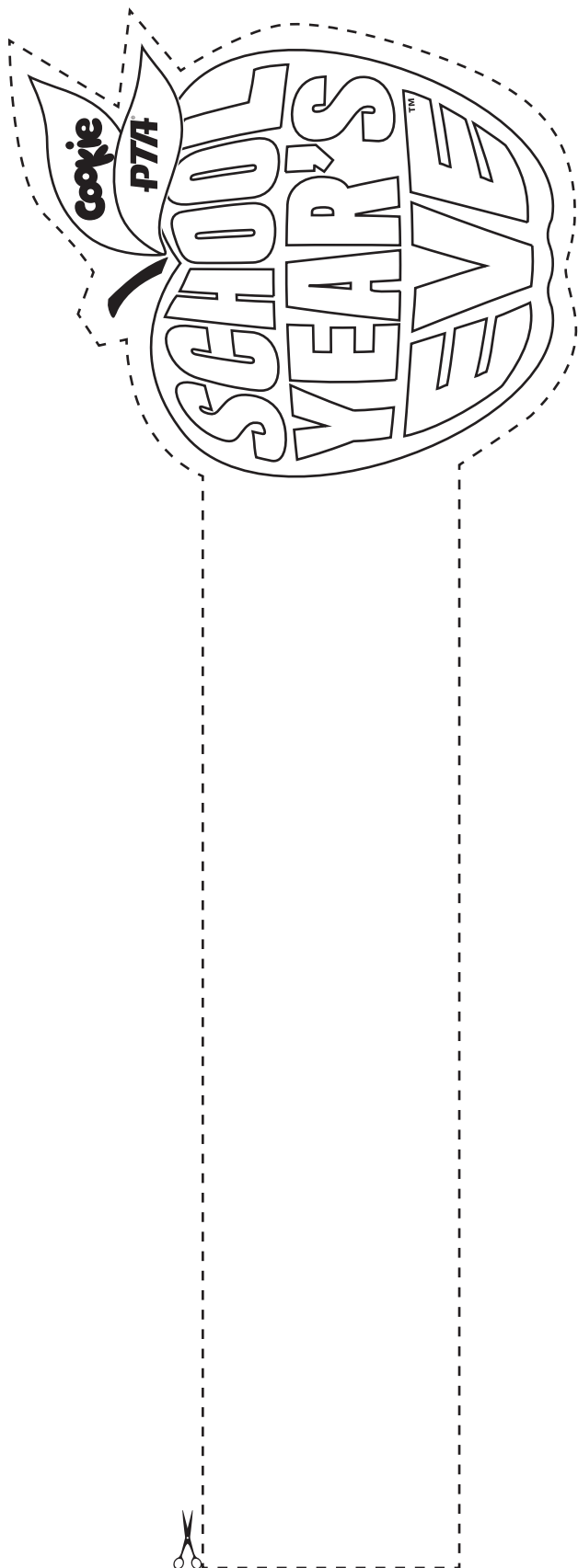


MAKE YOUR OWN NAPKIN RINGS

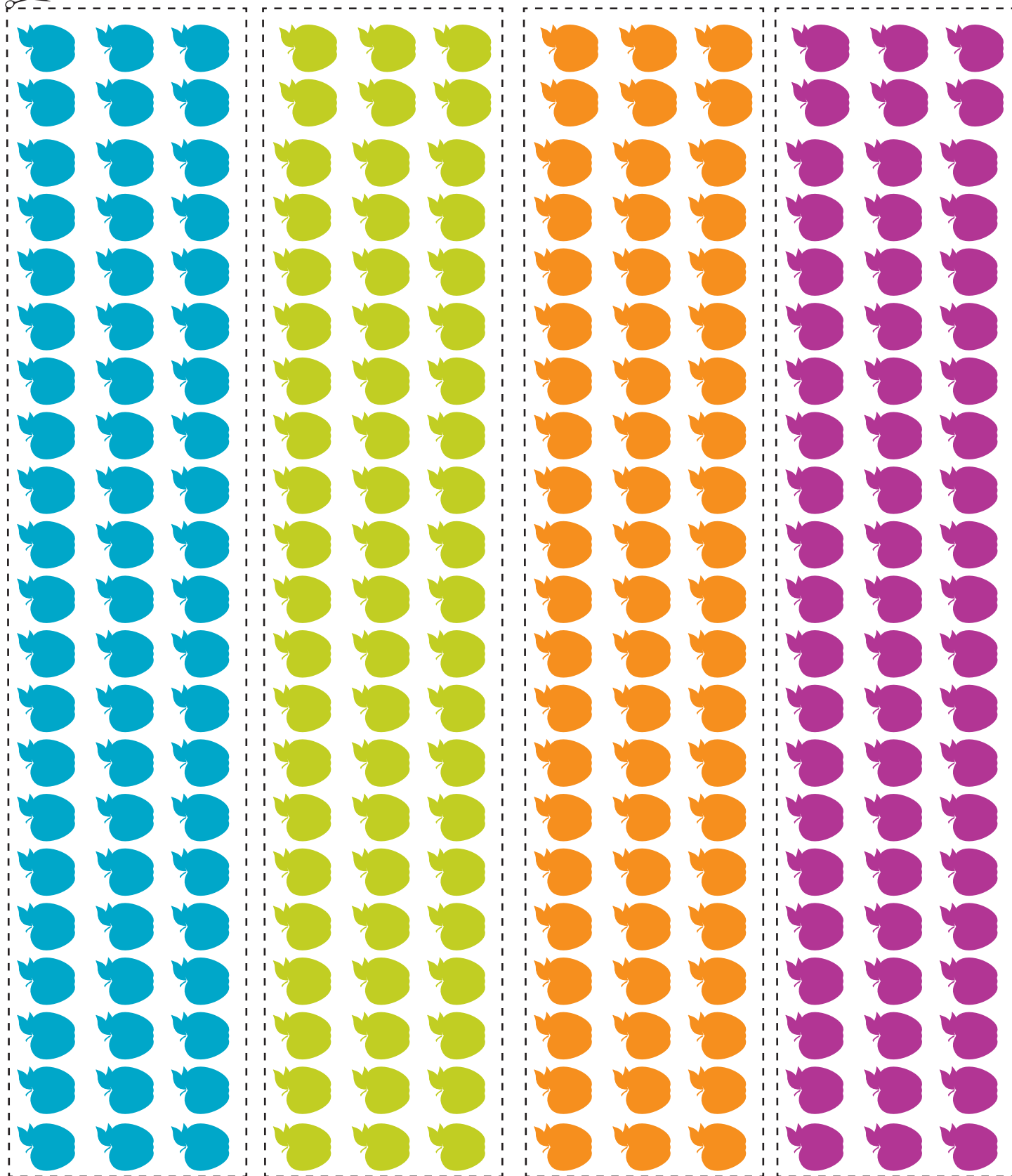
Print, cut along the dotted line, roll into a circle, and glue the ends together.

MAKE YOUR OWN NAPKIN RINGS

Cut a cardboard tube (from your paper towel, aluminum, or plastic wrap) at 1 1/2 inch rounds. Cut out the 2 1/2 wide strips (follow dotted lines). Cover the cardboard tubes with the strips of paper and glue together. For an extra nice touch, line the napking rings with a ribbon or a strip of paper.



MAKE YOUR OWN NAPKIN RINGS

Cut a cardboard tube (from your paper towel, aluminum, or plastic wrap) at 1½ inch rounds. Cut out the 2½ wide strips (follow dotted lines). Cover the cardboard tubes with the strips of paper and glue together. For an extra nice touch, line the napking rings with a ribbon or a strip of paper.
