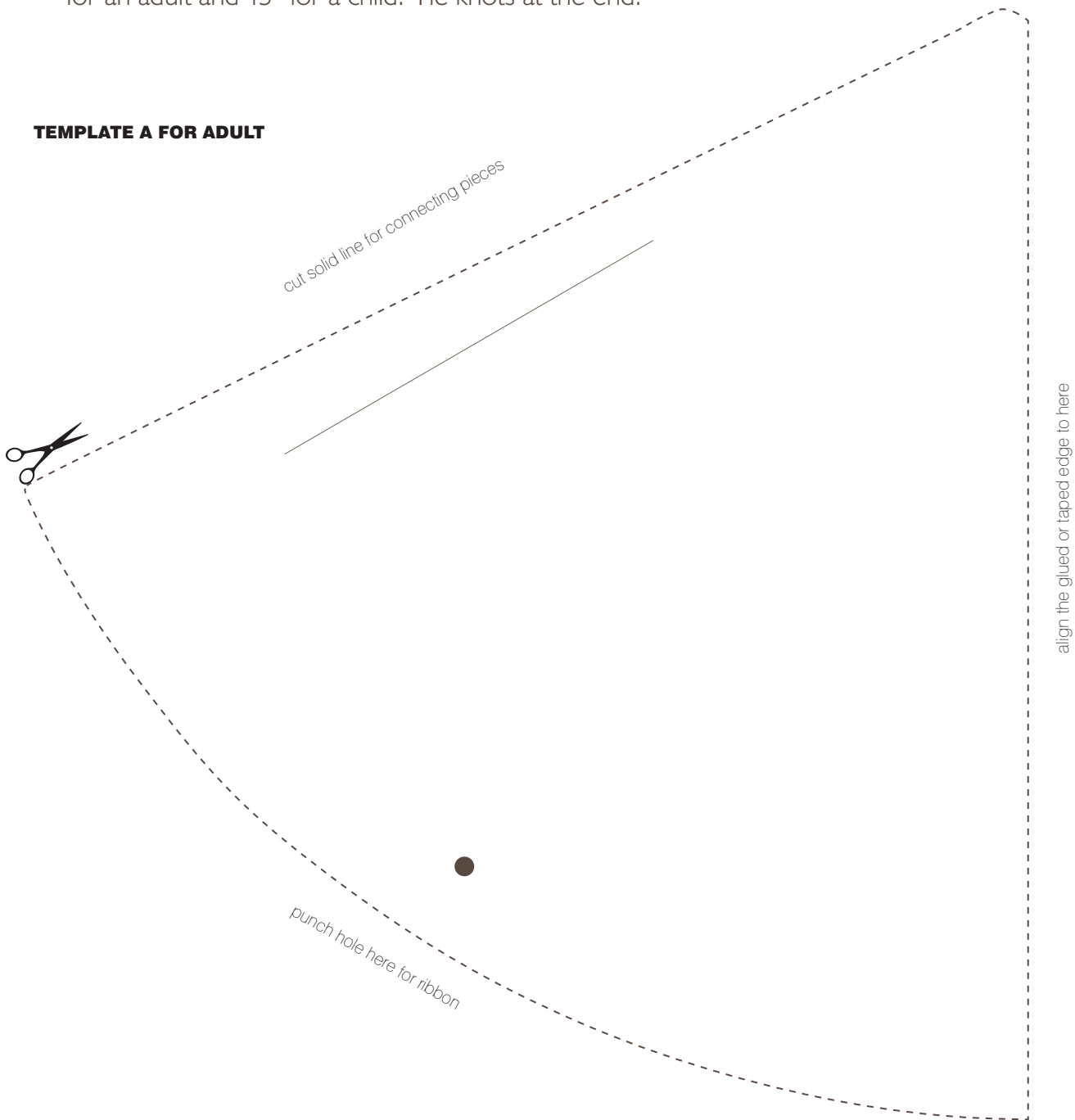


MAKE YOUR OWN PARTY HATS

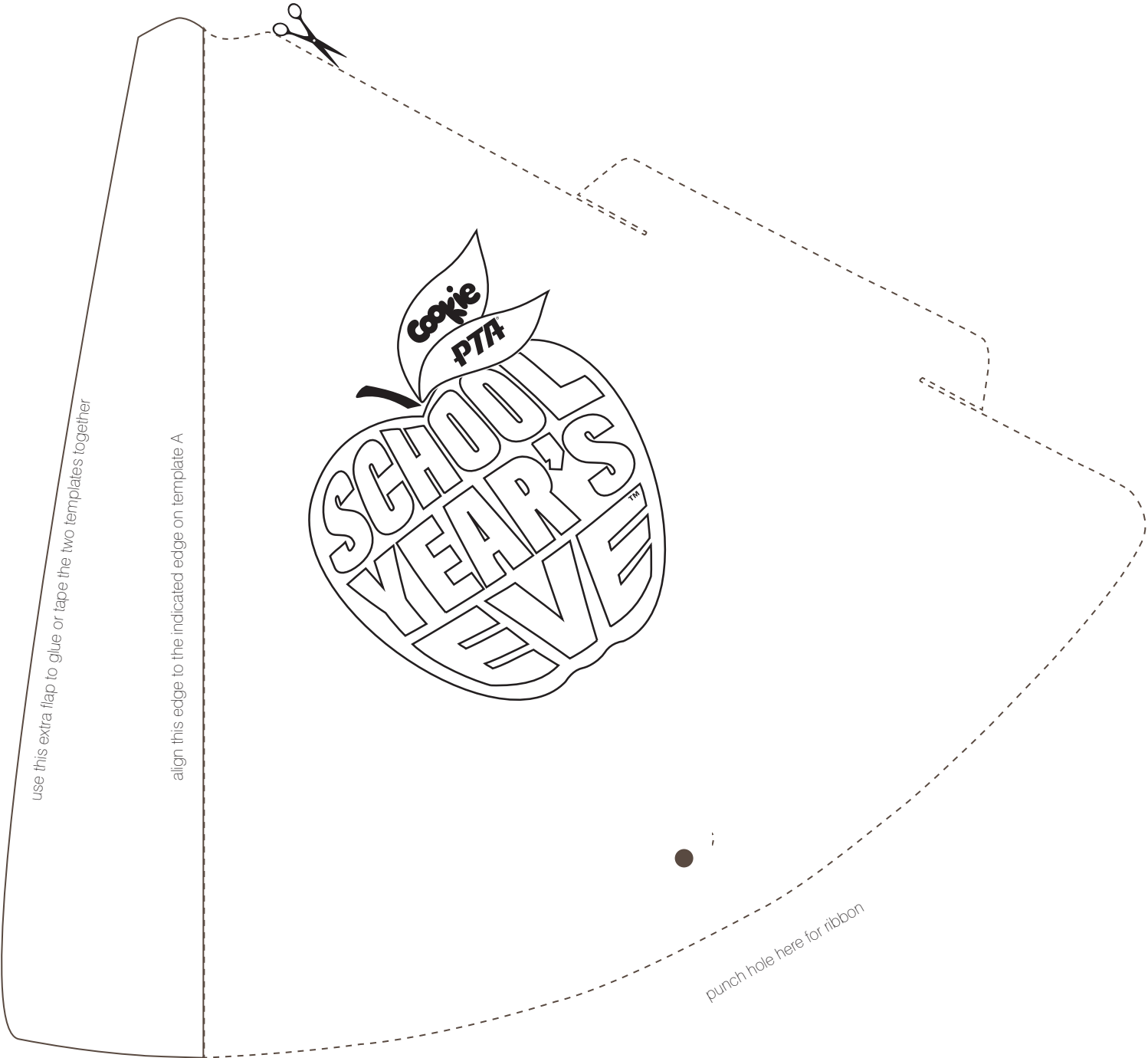
ADULT PARTY HAT DIRECTIONS

1. Print page (optional: paste onto heavy card stock) and cut along the dotted lines of templates A and B.
2. Connect the two pieces by sliding the tab from template B into the slit on template A.
3. Have fun decorating with confetti, googly eyes, marker, pencils, crayons, glue, and string.
4. Align the indicated straight edges together to make a cone shape.
5. Punch holes where indicated and weave in string, yarn, ribbon, or elastic. We recommend you measure, but the average is 15" of string needed for an adult and 13" for a child. Tie knots at the end.

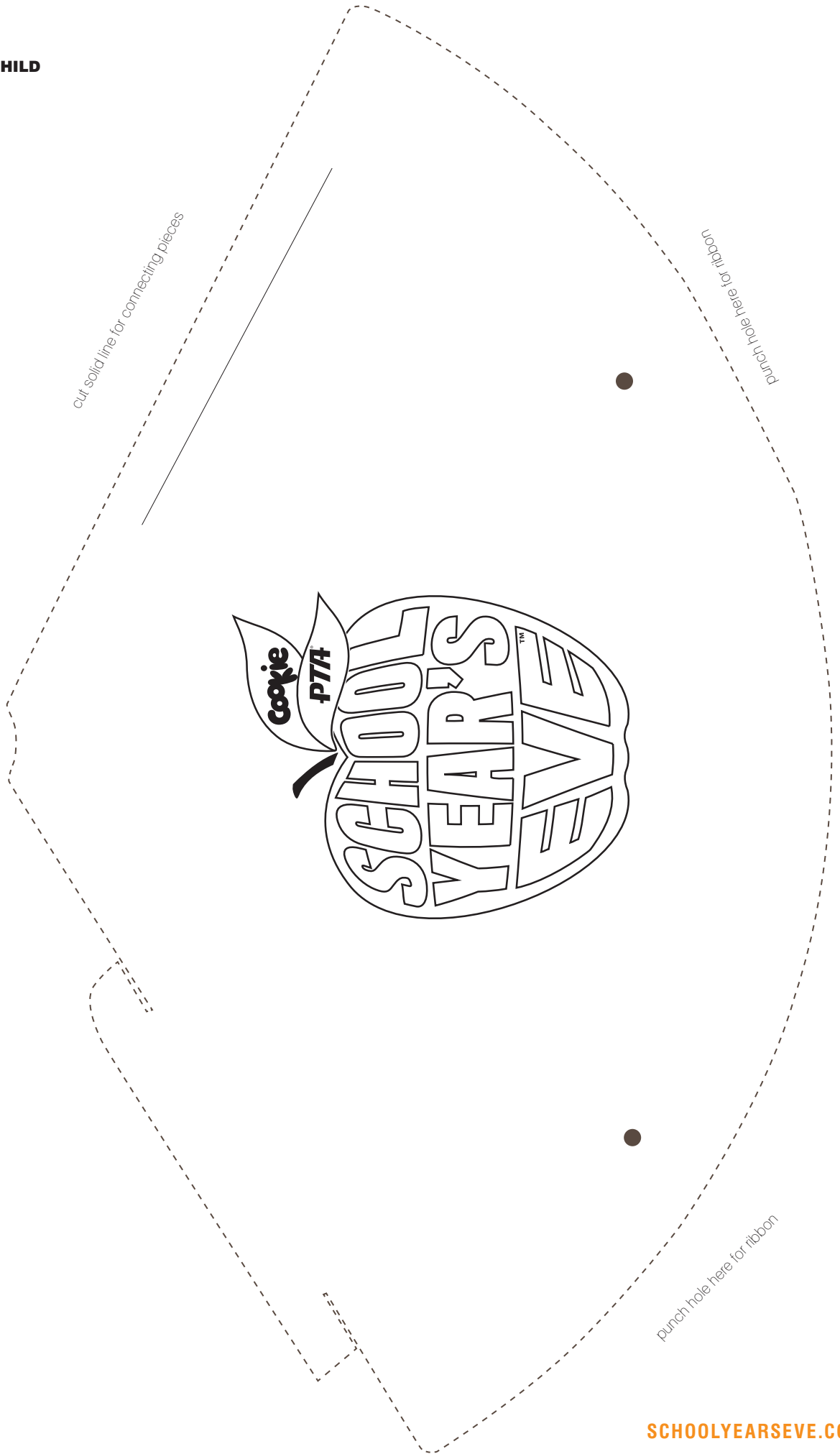
TEMPLATE A FOR ADULT

TEMPLATE FOR CHILD

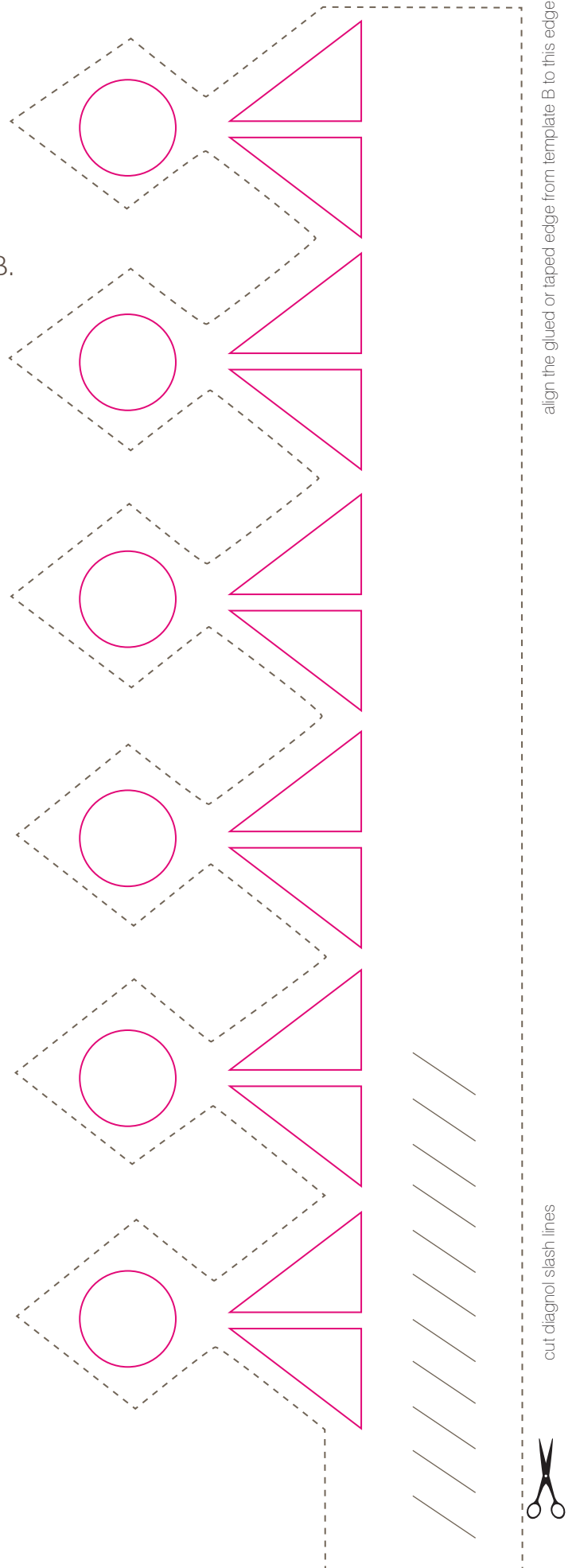

ADJUSTABLE CROWN HAT DIRECTIONS

1. Print page (optional: paste onto heavy card stock) and cut along the dotted lines of templates A and B.

4. Connect the two ends by sliding the hook from template B into one of the adjustable slits from template A.
